### **BUS PARAPROFESSIONAL**

Selected candidate in this position will serve students while on their bus route. This position will support an AM and PM route to a campus out of district. This position can be combined with classroom para duties as applicable.

#### **PRIMARY DUTIES / RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Assist students to seats and appropriately secure students in child restraint systems and wheelchair restraint systems where applicable
2. Assist bus driver with loading and unloading of special needs students, and during transport as needed
3. Assist bus driver in supervising conduct and behavior of students while on the bus
4. Assist with student health-related issues as needed
5. Assist bus driver with emergency bus evacuation in case of emergency
6. Maintain appropriate confidentiality pertaining to students, staff, and parents
7. Additional duties as assigned
