

Sophomore Officers/Sophomore Committee Information

Officer Information

- To run for Sophomore Officer, a candidate must have a **cumulative** grade point average of 3.0 or higher with no U(s) that haven't been made up for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd terms of the present school year (2021-2022). (NO exceptions and that means no 2.99 cumulative GPAs!)
- Students running for office must give a teacher evaluation to each of his/her current teachers. An average score lower than 90/120 (75%) will disqualify the candidate.
- All students running for office must maintain the standards set forth by the DHS constitution for the three succeeding terms prior to their election into office (2021-2022 school year). This includes but is not limited to; no in-school or out-of-school suspensions.
- All students running for office must be registered as **full-time sophomore students** at Davis High next year.
- All students running for office must be in the 9th grade at the time of the election and full-time students of one of the feeder junior highs (Fairfield, Kaysville, Shoreline)
- All students running for office must attend an information meeting in the spring of 2022, in Mrs. Money's room (DHS room 2307). Detailed information will be handed out at this meeting. Any student not in attendance must contact Mrs. Money before that day and meet with her in person to get all the information.

Committee Information

- To be on the Sophomore Committee, a student must have a **cumulative** grade point average of 2.0 or higher with no U(s) that haven't been made up for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd terms of the present school year (2021-2022). (NO exceptions and that means no 1.99 cumulative GPAs!)
- Students are appointed to the Sophomore Committee by the newly elected officers.
