Good Day, Lamoille Families:

With the decision by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to approve COVID-19 vaccination for children ages 5 to 11, Governor Phil Scott, the Vermont Agency of Human Services, and the Vermont Department of Health (VTDOH) announced that, starting at 8:00 a.m. Wednesday, November 3, 2021, parents and caregivers can register their eligible children to receive the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine.

Families will be able to make appointments for state-run sites through the Vermont [registration system](#). With support from EMS and other health care partners, the VTDOH has also arranged for clinics in nearly 100 schools across the state, including all of our schools, over a six-week period beginning on Monday, November 9, 2021, in Hyde Park.

These are closed clinics (no-public), except for parent/guardian accompanying a child. *Any child* can go to any school for the vaccine, it does not have to be the school that the child attends; any school throughout the state.
