## **Bullying**

White Bear Lake Area Schools and Otter Lake Elementary strictly prohibits any act of bullying. While we recognize our role is to enforce bullying policies, we value the role of families in also preventing and eliminating any acts of bullying within our school community.

The White Bear Lake Area Schools School Board (Policy #514) defines bullying: "Bullying" means intimidating, threatening, abusive, or harming conduct that is objectively offensive and:

1. an actual or perceived imbalance of power exists between the student engaging in the prohibited conduct and the target of the prohibited conduct, and the conduct is repeated or forms a pattern; or

2. materially and substantially interferes with a student's educational opportunities or performance or ability to participate in school functions or activities or receive school benefits, services, or privileges

If you are concerned your child is being bullied within the school environment, please reach out to our school. There are a variety of ways to do this:

- 1.) Contact your child's teacher
- 2.) Contact the building principal



The White Bear Area Food Shelf KidPack Program is a free, optional, supplemental weekend food program for Kindergarten to Fifth Grade Students. Enrolled Students will receive a bag of single-serve food items (including 2 breakfast, 4 lunches, and a handful of snack items) on the last day of the school week to bring home for the weekend. Common items include granola bars, applesauce cups, macaroni and cheese, cereal bowls, and meal kits. We ask that parents or guardians inform their children of food preparation safety practices and check all provided food before consumption.
