1. PURPOSE AND PHILOSOPHY

- 1.1. It is the policy of the Davis School District to adhere to and comply with Federal and State laws and rules as they pertain to students with disabilities and the provision of a free, appropriate, public education to all students within the District's jurisdiction. This includes:
