

Bilingual Diploma

In addition to the Alberta High School Diploma, WIC also offers a Bilingual Diploma (BD).

The key requirement is that students study in two languages (French & English). The BD is awarded to Gr. 12 students who have successfully completed 35 credits of study in which the language of instruction is French, one DELF Diploma (B1 or B2), and AP French Language & Culture.
