Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held for all elementary students on the afternoon and evening of Thursday, November 11, and on the morning of Friday, November 12. Please see the following schedule for students:

**Thursday, November 11: Early Dismissal Elementary ONLY**

\*Students in Grades 1-5 will have early dismissal this day. They will eat lunch at school and will begin to be **DISMISSED AT 12:45 P.M.**

\*Kindergartners **will** have school following the schedule below:

- **A.M. Kindergarten students will meet from 8:45 to 10:30 a.m.**  
**Parents will pick up their children at 10:30 a.m.**
- **P.M. Kindergarten students will meet from 11:15 a.m. to 12:45 p.m.**  
**Parents will drop off children at 11:15 a.m. and return home on their buses.**

**Friday, November 12: No School ONLY for elementary students.**

Conferences are designed to report student progress for the first nine weeks, and report cards will be distributed at this time for Grades 2-5. We strongly encourage your participation in these conferences, as they provide us with an opportunity to share information in the interest of your child's growth and development.

The homeroom teacher has already scheduled conferences via Signup Genius. If you still need to schedule a conference, please contact your student's homeroom teacher. If your conference is by Zoom, homeroom teachers will send parents the Conference Zoom link closer to Conference days. Signup Genius will send you a reminder of your parent/teacher conference time 4 days before your conference. Conferences are scheduled in 15 minute intervals so please be mindful of your appointment time. We look forward to seeing you then.

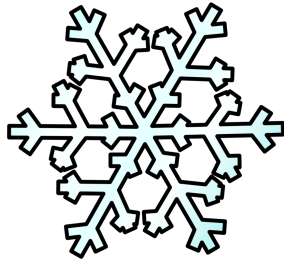


## #bethekindkid Merchandise Sale

## Guidelines for the contest:

1. Create a design that is 8 ½ inches by 5 ½ inches. This is the size of an 8 ½ X 11 inch sheet of paper folded in half.
2. Design must be original.
3. Keep the theme narrowed to “winter” or “holiday” themes that are appropriate for everyone. (Religious or “Santa” topics should be avoided.)
4. Photographs are also acceptable.
5. Create the design keeping in mind that it will be scanned and printed on an offset press. Line drawings and simple designs that translate easily to a duplicated one or two-color format are best.
6. Please write your name, grade, “Central Elementary”, “Ms. Koble”, and the material used on the BACK ONLY of the card. Also, students are to sign their names on the back, agreeing that the design is original.
7. Entries must be turned in to Ms. Koble by November 17, 2021
8. The final selection will be made by Administration.
9. The winner will be recognized at the January Board of School Directors meeting! School board members and administration will use the winning card designs for holiday cards sent to friends of Hampton Township School District!

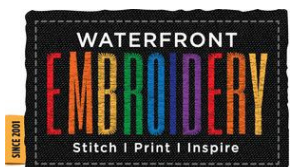

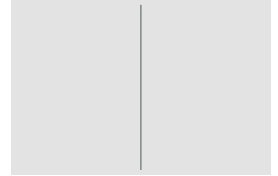

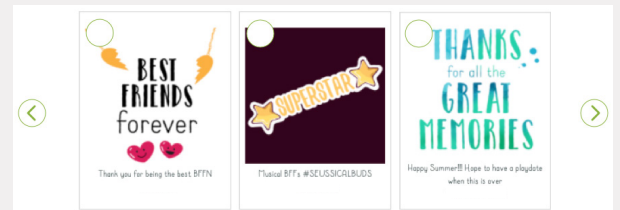
