Academics & Educational Activities

Open Makerspace Club Grades 3-5/ Grades 6-12

The purpose of this ECP activity is to enable students to have time to use the materials, tools and equipment in the Makerspace for their own projects. These may be an extension of their school work or based on their own interests. The Makerspace will be supervised and training and support will be given so participants can work in a safe, practical and creative environment. **This course runs in ECP Fall, Winter and Spring sessions.

Science Club Grades 4-6

Grades 4-6 students can enjoy fun science experiments and learn the basic science behind each experiment to expand their knowledge on science. In the Science Club, students will work together in small groups to design and carry out a scientific investigation into their chosen topic of interest. Students will have to work together to identify an issue they wish to investigate. They will plan a scientific investigation to collect sufficient relevant data to answer their research question. Students will then have to work together to draw conclusions and present their findings.

Robotics (Beginners)

Grades 1-6

Students will design and make a working robot to meet a series of challenges (walk, talk, dance, jump, fly) in order to demonstrate their understanding of robotics and artificial intelligence. The robots created will be automatically entered into the Korean Robotics competition. The students will explain how their robots work in detail and answer questions about their robots and win prizes. Students are motivated to learn by creating their own robotic devices, while at the same time gain a deeper understanding of interdisciplinary fields of study. In addition, robotics appeals to a broad range of students and allows multiple points of access to science and technology for a variety of learners. Students will build their own robot that will be supplied and theirs to keep.

EMD Debate courses have been carefully designed to ensure that students acquire not only sharp critical thinking skills, and

effective speaking ability, but also that they learn the importance of respecting one another and by extension respect everyone they meet and discuss important issues throughout their lives. We achieve this by exposing our students to the full spectrum of opposing arguments on any given topic before they enter into a substantive debate, so they will be able to fully understand not only their position but the position of their opponent as well.

International Award

Grades 8-12

The International Award is an internationally recognized framework for students to develop new skills, leadership and challenge themselves. Through a series of activities, a student works towards receiving the Bronze Award (followed by Silver and Gold). To receive this award, students complete and reflect on experiences in four sections, including:

1. Physical Recreation
2. Skills
3. Voluntary Service
4. Adventurous Journey (hiking, mountain biking, kayaking)

Additionally, to personal development, the program provides recognition for young people in the extra-curricular sphere of the school environment, and is a great program for a student to add to their CV to apply for a university.

Once a month (the first Wednesday of the month), students will have time to work independently to update their Online Record Book. **Students can complete all sections of the Award at their own pace!** They are able to take breaks if anything important is coming up (eg. an assessment, a holiday etc.) and continue again afterwards.

According to their personal ability, they could be able to receive an official black belt certificate provided from WTF (World Taekwondo Federation). For the students who train exceptionally well, they will be rewarded with more personal training from Master Kim, allowing them to begin participating in official international Taekwondo competitions.

Learning to pull yourself up on the bar, hold yourself upside down, and hang from the bars challenges students in both strength and endurance.
