

# COVID-19 - Confirmed or Presumptive Case

**What to do if you get a confirmed or presumptive case of COVID-19**

INFORM  
SPS

If you test positive for COVID-19, and you have **symptoms**, you can end home isolation and return to SPS when:

- You have been fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication **AND**
- The symptoms have improved **AND**
- At least 10 days have passed since the symptoms first appeared **AND**
- Your health care provider (HCP) has certified that you are COVID-free **OR** the County Health Department has given you a return to school date

*(Your HCP must send a note to the school.)*

If you test positive for COVID-19, but have had **no symptoms**, you can end home isolation and return to SPS when:

- 10 days have passed since the date of your first positive COVID-19 test **AND**
- You have no subsequent illness **AND**
- Your HCP has certified that you are COVID-free **OR** the County Health Department has given you a return to school date

*(Your HCP must send a note to the school.)*
