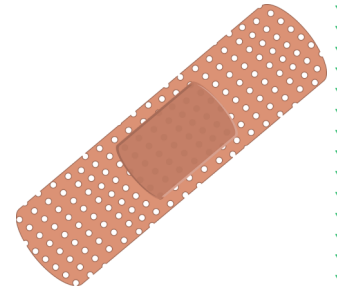
Pupil Parliament

Medical Tracker

First Aid Incident Notifications



To help make improvements in first aid incident notifications we have decided to use a service called Medical Tracker. This will only be used when your child has a head bump or head injury.

Medical Tracker will be beneficial to you because:

- We can record and track first aid incidents that involve your child
- You can be notified immediately after a first aid head incident by email, for any major injuries there will also be a phone call.

To use Medical Tracker effectively we need you as parents to ensure you keep us updated with the best email address to use to notify you of incidents. You can update us on any changes by emailing into the academy office.
