Greetings RHS Families,

We have reached the midway point of our first semester for the 2021-2022 school year. A vast majority of our efforts thus far have centered on making students feel welcomed, comfortable, and supported in their learning. We have also been working on a variety of intervention strategies to address learning loss due to COVID-19. One of the lingering fallouts of this learning loss is a significant dip in educational stamina. Our students are getting used to the pace of 'regular school', attending five days per week, and simultaneously learning new material and readdressing things they may not have covered in previous courses due to our steadfast commitment to teaching essential curriculum during the peak of the pandemic.

You will find your child/ren's midterm grades posted by the end of the day Monday. Please know that this is a snapshot of their performance in their given courses to date. It provides an accurate data point so you can check in with them regarding their performance, effort, and any issues they may need to address using self-advocacy skills. These grades are not exported or shared with institutions of higher education (IHEs), reported on transcripts, or memorialized externally in any other way. That said, we do encourage you to speak with your child about their learning stamina, discuss current performance, and make a plan to be most successful for the remainder of the semester (as semester grades are reported on their permanent transcript).

While almost all of our fall sports have come to a conclusion, we wish our individual cross country participants the best of luck at the state meet this weekend! Between blowing leaves, bleeding sprinkler lines, and transitioning from Halloween to Thanksgiving decorations I hope you are able to take a moment to relax, enjoy your wonderful high school children, and gear up for a great week over the weekend!
