AFTER SCHOOL

HERE are the things you need to know about coming to school in-person.

- **YOU MUST WEAR A MASK COVERING YOUR NOSE AND MOUTH** Students that do not comply with this request will be sent home.
- **Drop-off and Pick-up** – DO NOT get dropped off using the main entrance. Use the parking lot just south of the main entrance. School will open at 7:00 and breakfast will be available. Students should be picked up at 3:35.
- **Uniform** – You are expected to be in full uniform. During the cold days you may wear/carry your coat.
- If you are getting lunch, you **MUST HAVE** your student ID OR know your student ID number.
