## Picture Retakes: Friday Nov. 19th

**Seniors**: It's time to apply for financial aid for college! The first step is to complete "FAFSA".

**Background Info:** FAFSA is an application to get financial aid to pay for college. It provides access to scholarships, grants, and loans (at a local, state, and national level). You enter information about your family's finances, and then the information gets sent to your future college. In the spring, your future college will offer you a "financial aid package" and you choose whether to accept or deny each offering.

#### Steps:

- 1. Make sure you have created your FSA ID account and can log in.
- 2. Go to: fafsa.gov
- 3. Click "Start Here" and select whether you are the student or the parent.
- 4. Complete an application for the 2022-23 school year.

**Questions?** Reach out to your school counselor. (Note: the "WASFA" is a similar application for certain non-citizen students. School counselors can help you decide which application is right for you.)

**Do you have a 3.5 GPA?** Do you enjoy serving your community?

If so, you are invited to join **NVHS Honor Society**! Honor Society is a great opportunity to serve your community, build leadership skills, and strengthen your resume for work and college!

Students must maintain a cumulative 3.5 GPA and complete 12 service hours by the end of the school year to earn the designation of being in Honor Society. Have questions? Talk walk with Mrs. Eastman in the counseling hub.
