The Pre-Public examinations are important as they provide students and staff with information about strengths, allow them to see progress they have made over the course of the term and, most importantly, identify areas they still need to focus on during Year 11.


Students have been preparing for these examinations since the start of the year, with revision technique sessions in tutor time. They were also provided with a framework for a revision timetable prior to half term. We know that examinations can be a stressful time for students and encourage students to focus on making the most of the opportunity to demonstrate what they can do, areas for development will be addressed in classes following feedback from the examinations. Please support in ensuring that your child brings appropriate food and a water bottle to school and encourage a good night's sleep to be both physically and mentally prepared. Punctuality is crucial during this time so that students are able to maximise their time on each exam. Students will need black pens for all examinations, along with a pencil, ruler, sharpener and eraser. Specialist equipment such as calculators, protractors and a pair of compasses are needed for Maths and Science examinations. We recommend that students wear face coverings when in examinations, due to the larger group setting and current prevalence of COVID-19 Nationally.
