The Ministry of Altar Servers: Altar Servers assist the priest and, in particular, lead the Opening and Closing Processions, assist with the Ritual Binder, prepare the vessels and altar at Mass. Servers are also needed at funerals and weddings. The role of server is integral to the normal celebration of the Mass. All young men and women, grade 3 through 8 are invited to become an altar server. Servers should be mature enough to understand their responsibilities and to carry them out well and with appropriate reverence. They should have already received 1st Holy Communion and usually receive the Eucharist whenever they participate in the liturgy. Servers are prepared for this ministry through initial training and on-going formation offered in the parish. Training



will take place on Mon. Nov. 15 at 3:30pm and on Sat. Nov 20 at 9:30am in the Church. Only one session is required and at least one parent must attend. 



BETTER CARE GUIDE: TIPS ABOUT SOCIAL SECURITY - The AARP Bulletin recently ran a cover story of how to "Beat the System." Last week's column featured a tip about reaching the IRS. This week it's about what to do when it comes to dealing with Social Security issues. For straightforward tasks, like signing up for Social Security for yourself or claiming spousal benefits after your spouse has already claimed, your best bet is to simply go through the application on the agency's website, according to Philip Moeller, author of "Get What's Yours: The Secrets to Maxing Out Your Social Security." If you're dealing with a more complicated application or running into trouble online, he recommends making an appointment at a field office. To increase your chances of getting an appointment that you want, he says to call at least two months in advance of your preferred appointment time.

He also suggests calling more remote field offices for details. Going to uncongested areas and offices with simple parking can make the process less stressful. Use the online Social Security Field Office Locator, ssa.gov/locator, to find other branches' phone number and hours.
