PARENT INVOLVEMENT FUNDS

By law, at least 1% of Calvert County’s Title I allocation must be set-aside for Parent and Family Engagement activities.

At Calvert Elementary, the set-aside for 2021-2022 is \$8604.00.

In 2020-2021, these funds were used to pay for salaries and wages for events (teachers and FICA), contracted services for transportation if needed, enhance/replenish the Family Lending Library materials and at-home learning resources and supplies.
