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### **SCHOOL GOAL #1**

K-2nd students based on the 2019/20 end of the year Benchmark level Screener results will show that 50% of students are at challenge or at benchmark in reading.

3-5th. Based on the 2019/20 SBAC data results students will improve from 36% of students meeting or exceeding standards in reading to 45% of students.

6th-8th. based on the 19'-20' SBAC data student results will improve from 46% of students meeting or exceeding standards in reading to 60% of students.

3-5th. Based on the 2019/20 SBAC data results students will improve from 43% of students meeting or exceeding standards in math to 60% of students.

6th-8th Based on the 19'-20' SBAC data results students will improve from 54% of students meeting or exceeding standards in math to 65% of students.

**SCHOOL GOAL #2**

The percentage of students who reclassify from English Learner to Reclassified Fully English Proficient (RFEP) will improve by 10% in the 2019-2020 school year based on the data from the previous year.

**SCHOOL GOAL # 3** By May 30<sup>th</sup> 2020, 90% of students will report feeling “safe” or “very safe” on the student survey. We will compare this data with the previous year data

**SCHOOL GOAL #4** maintain a high level of parent engagement to support our student achievement goal in Reading/Language Arts, Math, English learners and students with disabilities

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
