

Single stream makes recycling easier, but not all recyclable items are accepted.
Only the following pictured items should be placed in your school's recycling bin.

Aluminum and Tin Cans



Glass Bottles and Jars



Plastic Bottles and Jugs



Paper

(Office, Newspaper, Glossy Inserts, Magazines and Telephone, Hardback, and Paperback Books)



Paper Cardboard Dairy and Juice Cartons



Flattened Cardboard and Paperboard



All items must be free of food waste. Do not place recyclables inside black or white trash bags.
Some Items NOT accepted single stream include: Styrofoam, plastic bags, toys, light bulbs, ceramics, electronics, ink cartridges, paint cans, and food.

School Recycling Tips

- Collected recycling must be placed in the school’s recycling dumpster.
- Look for a “recycling only” or “single stream recycling” decal to identify which dumpster is for recycling.



- Recyclable items can be loose or in large, clear plastic bags or paper bags (No black bags).
- Shredded Paper must be bagged using clear bags.
- Staples are acceptable.
- Service issues related to the collection of the recycling dumpsters should be directed to your school’s building service manager.
