- Ralph Wilkins & Karen Hall led attendance introductions.
- Amber Carter & Sherri Fitzpatrick with BACODA, reviewed the 8-page drug survey given to students last Spring. Information packets were handed out, containing the STATS for alcohol & drug use in the schools, the popular drugs used today. There was a mock bedroom display depicting items where students can hide drugs. The display is titled "Hidden in Plain Sight" for parents and staff to view. A sub-committee was formed.
- Ralph Wilkins gave the Nutrition update: New products were introduced during the National School Lunch Week.
- Jo Johnson of IYG gave updates on the Human Sexuality Sub-Committee meeting held on Tuesday, October 26<sup>th</sup>. 14 members attended. Evidence based programs & their websites were presented.
- James Odom gave a Restorative Practices report and spoke about the needs assessment he
  conducted recently and how to better serve La Porte ISD. He is doing district-wide trainings on
  strategies to help students learn, learn from mistakes, and showing counselors how to better
  utilize restorative practice circles & participation community circles. Solving conflict was
  discussed with the use of mediations. 19 mediations have taken place & 53 students were
  involved at LPHS. Most of the time, the conflict has been resolved.
- Janet Zaborowski & Stacey Brittain spoke about Suicidality; the stats, precursors, multiple risk factors, & pre-existing situations.
- Janet Zaborowski ended the meeting with a 10-minute mindful meditation. We left the meeting more at peace and quite relaxed.
