Greetings Purple Knight Family,

Progress Reports were sent to students and their parents and guardians electronically April 17<sup>th</sup>. If you have not received yours, please contact your respective teachers through email correspondence. We continue to reach out to parents and students concerning the importance of submitting quality assignments on time. Parents please review these progress reports for any missing assignments. Zeros have been placed as grade holders for missing assignments. Students can still make up these assignments. If you have any questions, please contact teachers and/or staff immediately.

Beginning May 4<sup>th</sup>, Senior exams will take place as scheduled on the school calendar. New assignments will not be given during the week of April 27<sup>th</sup>. Instead this week will be used for exam review and will also allow students who are behind in their assignments to make them up. Those students that have submitted all their assignments can focus on this exam review week. Those Seniors that have not completed assignments will receive an additional week to submit all assignments that were due prior to April 27<sup>th</sup>. However, the exam review process will continue for all Seniors by their teachers in each subject during this week. It is in the best interests of our young men that they focus on making the very best grade possible. Seniors that have been more adversely affected by COVID-19 can take advantage of the week of April 27<sup>th</sup> to complete and submit assignments.

Senior T-shirts have been ordered and procedures for their dissemination will be made known in advance of distribution. Senior week, graduation exercises, and the 8<sup>th</sup> grade promotional program details have not been finalized and will be forthcoming. We understand that our students, especially the Seniors, have had a disruption to normal end of school year ceremonies and procedures. Please know that the Leadership Team is working diligently behind the scenes to give you, Seniors '20, the graduation ceremony you have earned and deserve. Eight grade promotion activities are also being planned for our 8<sup>th</sup> grade students.

For 8<sup>th</sup> -11<sup>th</sup> grade students, your exam review week will take place during school days from May 7<sup>th</sup> through May 13<sup>th</sup>, and your exams will take place May 14<sup>th</sup> through May 19<sup>th</sup>, as regularly scheduled on the school calendar. New assignments will not be given the week of May 4<sup>th</sup>. Therefore, allowing students to submit any assignments that are still required by their teachers. May 22<sup>nd</sup> will be the date Final Report Cards will be distributed electronically to students, parents, and guardians.

Parents and guardians, an Intent to Return form, for the 2020-2021 school year, has been sent to your email addresses on file with the school. As of this message 53% of you have filled out the form and have submitted your responses. For those parents who have not, please do so as soon as possible. The deadline listed for the electronic return of the form is Friday, April 24, 2020. Follow up phone calls will be made where needed.

In addition, St. Augustine High School will be sending out electronic forms for returning 2020-2021 school year students to select the electives they wish to have scheduled where applicable. Given the priority of classes listed, elective classes will be filled based upon availability and quick response. Thus, when you receive this form please fill it out accordingly and submit it as soon as possible. Notification will be sent to parents when the form is made available.

We understand that these are trying times for everyone, especially our Seniors. We are committed to formally honoring the graduation class of "2020".
