

ABOUT DIS

- Founded in 1987; joined Mission Laïque
 Française (MLF) in 1991 under the name Dallas
 International School.
- The only PreK-12 French-English bilingual school in the Dallas Fort-Worth metroplex area.
- Rigorous multilingual academics
- French international programs and IB curriculum in a multilingual and interticultural environment.
- Total enrollment: 530 students 347 primary students (PreK to 5th grade); 183 secondary students (6th to 12th).
- 33 nationalities represented.

UPPER SCHOOL OVERVIEW

- All core academic courses should be considered to be at "honors" level.
- DIS does not rank; all GPAs at DIS are unweighted.
- All students prepare for either the French
 Baccalaureate Diploma or the International
 Baccalaureate Diploma and the Texas High School
 Diploma.
- In the French track, all 9th grade students take the Brevet exam, a worldwide French examination. The diploma is contingent upon passing the exam and successfully completing all required courses.
- DIS graduates exceed the expectation of the State of Texas Distinguished Achievement Program (DAP)
 Graduation requirements.
- DIS follows a semester system.
- 9 Varsity Sports; 11 clubs and activities; 5 Honor Societies

FRENCH BACCALAUREATE

- The baccalaureate diploma is awarded upon passing the FB exams and successfully completing all required courses and assignments.
- 1-20 point grading system. US equivalent is obtained through a specific scale and not by multiplying by 5 to reach a scale of 100.
- Overall average of 16+ considered "Exceptional".
- 10 is the minimum average score required to earn the French Baccalaureate.



INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE

- The IB Diploma is contingent upon passing the IB exams and successfully completing all required courses and assignments.
- DIS uses the US 1-100 grading scale.
- Lowest passing grade is 70.
- A maximum of 45 points can be awarded to an IB student; 42 points generated across the 6 subjects and 3 bonus points derived from Theory of Knowledge and the Extended Essay.
- 24 is the minimum score required to earn the IB diploma.








FRENCH BACCALAUREATE


The French Baccalaureate (FB) is an academically rigorous diploma awarded by the French Ministry of National Education. FB exams are externally assessed and scored. Students follow rigorous core courses (English, French Literature, German, Mandarin or Spanish, Philosophy, PE, Sciences, World History & Geography) and are required to choose three high-level courses called "Specialty Courses" from Biology, Economics, Global Politics & Political Sciences, Mathematics and Physics & Chemistry. All courses are taught in French with the exception of English, Art, and PE.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE

100% of registered IB students passed the regular IB Diploma, 89% passed the Bilingual IB Diploma and 100% passed the Advanced Bilingual IB Diploma. 100% of registered students obtained the IB Certificate. These diplomas require fluency in French, in addition to English.
