Student Dress

Student dress shall be neat, clean, and within the bounds of decency, health, and safety. Dress and appearance is the responsibility of the parent and the student; however; dress and appearance shall not be disruptive to the educational process or learning objectives. Students need to dress appropriately to learn. A student who wears clothing that disrupts the educational process will be referred to an administrator (see District Policy #3224)

Each building has specific dress code details not necessarily addressed in this Policy #3224. However, District Policy #3224 is intended to include and encompass each building dress code details that are outlined in their student handbook. Principals have the latitude to make reasonable adjustments to the building dress code depending on the changing fashion of students.

Consequences

Students not following the building guidelines will be asked to change their clothing, cover up, or go home to change if necessary. Teachers/Administrators may offer students T-shirts/ sweatshirts to cover inappropriate clothing. Administrators will make the final judgment concerning the appropriateness of clothing. Parents will be notified of an on-going problem. Inability to follow these guidelines will be considered a disciplinary infraction. Students sent home because of inappropriate clothing and who miss class will be considered unexcused.
