I hope you will be able to join us on Monday, November 29 at 7:00 PM for our Commissioning Mass.



She has most recently served as the business manager of St. Pius X Catholic Parish and School.





## DIVINE CHILD RELICS OF THE WEEK St. Gertrude: November 16 St. Elizabeth of Hungary: November 17

Divine Child has 43 Relics in our Eucharistic Adoration Chapel and St. Gertrude & St. Elizabeth are two of them! You may view a list of DC's relics located on the bookshelf in the Adoration Chapel.

**St. Gertrude the Great,** was born on January 6, 1256 in Germany. Gertrude, known for being charming and able to win people over, entered the Benedictine Order at Helfta and became a nun. Her deep relationship with the Lord in prayer led to her being hailed as a mystic. She was also regarded as a great theologian. In 1281, 25-year-old Gertrude experienced her first series of visions that would continue until the day she passed away. Gertrude once had a vision on the feast of John the Evangelist, described in Gertrude's writings. As she rested her head near Jesus' wound on His side, she could hear the beating of His heart. She asked St. John if he, too, felt the beating of Jesus' Divine Heart on the night of the Last Supper. He told her he was saving this revelation for a time when the world needed it to rekindle its love. She died in November of 1301. She is the Patroness of the West Indies and is often invoked for souls in purgatory.

**St. Elizabeth** of Thuringia, was born in Hungary on July 7, 1207 to the Hungarian King Andrew II and Gertrude of Merania. Elizabeth's mother, Gertrude, was murdered in 1213, when Elizabeth was just six-years-old. In 1221, she was married to Ludwig, whom she deeply loved. Together the couple had three beautiful children, two of whom became members of nobility and the third entering the religious life, becoming abbess of a German convent. Ludwig and Elizabeth were politically powerful and lived with a remarkable generosity toward the poor to which she founded a hospital. After her husband died, she joined the Third Order of St. Francis and ministered to the sick and poor. She passed away at the age of 24. Patron saint of: bakers; beggars; brides; charities; death of children; homeless people; hospitals; Sisters of Mercy; widows .


### **Congratulations, Victoria Succurro!**

Whimsies, a porcelain, glazed miniature which began in 1970 in Red Rose tea boxes as a freebie. Wade of England has made these on and off for years. Some of these miniatures are valued anywhere from \$3-\$20 each. Wade manufactured "theme" items for the Red Rose Tea Company. Of particular interest was the set of "ark" animals accompanied by Noah and his wife, based upon authentic biblical sources. Likewise, the "endangered animals" theme set is another wonderful addition to our Project as it focuses and enhances not only Jesus, our Good Shepherd, but St. Francis who is widely known to even calm a wolf on one hand and pet a gentle lamb using the other hand.





#### Anointing of the Sick

Please call the Rectory Office to request this Sacrament. In emergency situations when the office is closed, the emergency line attendant will take the call.

#### **Baptisms**

Arrangements must be made in advance and parents must attend a **Baptism class** prior to the Baptism. The Church requires that at least one of the parents and one of the godparents/sponsors be practicing Catholics; that is, they attend Mass each weekend.

#### Marriages

One person of the couple must be an active, registered parishioner of Divine Child for at least 6 months. (Exceptions are made for DC alumni.) The Church requires a minimum of 6 months for marriage preparation. Potential wedding date is not confirmed until couple meets with a Divine Child priest. The celebrant will be a Divine Child priest unless the couple has someone close to them who is a Catholic priest. Music for the liturgy must be coordinated with our Director of Music Ministry, Mr. Matthew Simpson.

#### Funerals

Arrangements are made in conjunction with the funeral home. Eulogies must be given at the funeral home or at the funeral luncheon; no eulogies at the funeral Mass, please. Memorial Masses are scheduled Monday-Friday only.
