- **Outpatient Services and Early Childhood Interventions:**
 - **Spindletop Center:**
 - **Outpatient Services:** Community support services and skills training are provided up to 10 hours a month in the home, school, or other appropriate settings. Target population ranges in ages from 3 to 17.
 - **Youth Empowerment Services (YES Waiver):** Medicaid program that partners with families and the community to ensure qualifying Texas youth have access to a variety of community-based services and supports. Target population ranges in ages from 3 to 18.
 - **Early Childhood Intervention:** Offers family-centered community-based services and supports for families and their children 0 to 3 who have developmental delays, a medical condition that is likely to result in a delay or who have atypical development, including serious vision and/or hearing impairments.

 - **The ARC of Greater Beaumont:**
 - Facilitates a **parents night out/kids night** in for children 4-12 with intellectual and developmental disabilities including their siblings. Parents can enjoy a night out while their children engage in fun activities such as crafts, movies, and sports equipment to play with.
 - Provides **social support groups** for families of children with Down Syndrome and Autism to get together to socialize their children and share knowledge, resources, and experiences.
 - Hosts **ARC Summer Day Camps** for children ages 4-12 with intellectual and developmental disabilities or related conditions (i.e.- autism).
