- B. The Board discussed how remote learning/ hybrid has been going since the remodel began. 15 Students have been doing hybrid and this has helped improved student performance. Outreach coordinators have made an impact
- C. Dr. Cole reported again on the SAT and ACT Standardized Testing. The students who have taken their ACT tests have shown solid scores and a great improvement by students overall.
