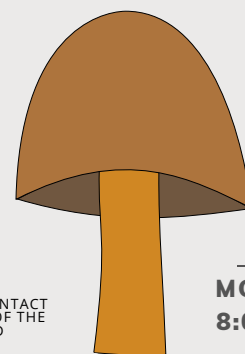

FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, WE ARE LEARNING ABOUT HOW SELF-CONTROL HELPS US TO MAKE BETTER CHOICES. SELF-CONTROL SKILLS AND STRATEGIES CAN BRING A CALMER AWARENESS TO MIND AND BODY.

A FAMILIAR GAME OR ACTIVITY PLAYED WITH ALTERED RULES CAN HELP STUDENTS NAVIGATE FRUSTRATIONS USING SELF-CONTROL STRATEGIES. STUDENTS WILL SEE THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING FLEXIBLE THINKERS WHO USE POSITIVE PROBLEM-SOLVING TECHNIQUES. FOR EXAMPLE, IF WE WERE TO PLAY A SIMPLE GAME OF MEMORY, A WIN WOULD NOW BE EQUAL TO A NON-MATCHING SET OF CARDS. STUDENTS MAY EMPLOY THE STOP, THINK AND CHOOSE METHOD OR BREATHING STRATEGIES.

ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO PRACTICE SELF-CONTROL IN YOUR HOME TODAY! AS ALWAYS, I'LL BE THERE FOR YOU AND YOUR STUDENTS.
