WHEREAS, the October enrollment for 2020 was 1,958.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the River Valley Local School District hereby establishes a service fund to be set aside as an amount within the general fund. The amount established and appropriated will not exceed \$20,000, which shall be incorporated in the appropriations of the District for FY22.

**SUPERINTENDENT’S COMMUNICATIONS/REPORTS:**

**Superintendent Shares Oral/Written Correspondence/Communications:**

Mr. Wickham discussed the updated quarantine guidance from the Ohio Department of Health and how this will impact our students and staff throughout the remainder of this school year. He also gave an update regarding the COVID-19 vaccine and its availability to K-12 staff. The FFCRA expired December 31, 2020 and was not included in the newly passed COVID relief package, but an extension of this leave to River Valley staff for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year is on today’s agenda. An update regarding several legislative items, such as HB409, were also presented to the Board.

**River Valley Local Schools Building Reports/Updates:** At this time, we would like to have building principals and our student representative give the board a brief update.

Mrs. Comstock presented on behalf of Heritage Elementary regarding the third-grade reading guarantee, scheduling kindergarten screening and that the building only has approximately 12.5% of its students choosing online for the next semester.

Mr. Douce gave an update from the District’s technology department. He gave a “shout out” to the stream team who has been streaming all winter sport events requiring quite a bit of time commitment. The students seem to be taking quite a bit of pride in providing the streaming to our community. Looking to sell quite a few Chromebook carts since we are now one-to-one and don’t have the space to continue storing them if we don’t intend to use them anymore.

Mr. Dutt presented on behalf of the High School regarding the second semester material pickup they held the prior week, state testing being complete, ACT being conducted all online this year for all juniors instead of paper and pencil, the bowling team is having a great season and gave accolades to a couple bowlers who have had some great accomplishments with their scores.

Mr. Gliebe presented on behalf of the Middle School regarding the building having approximately 24% of its students choosing to be fully remote for the second semester, how the HS and MS plan to allocate their MAWAC grant funds for the remainder of this year, providing two new learning labs to MS students.

Mrs. Richards presented on behalf of Liberty Elementary regarding the third-grade reading guarantee for her building, focusing on connecting with families the past two weeks while students

have been remote, preschool registration scheduled for March and the building having approximately 10% of its students choosing remote learning for the second semester.

Wesley Stephens presented on behalf of the students regarding syllabus week for CCP students, winter sports being in full swing and there will be no blood drive this year due to COVID.

Mr. Stout presented on behalf of the 6-12 Athletic Department regarding all winter sports being on schedule to complete most, if not all, of their season despite the challenges everyone has faced with COVID. He also spoke about the bowling teams being undefeated, school records being broken and spring sport practices have started indoors.
