If an entire school must enter full remote learning, here is what families can expect:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Students will be provided with both synchronous and asynchronous learning and follow the Red Schedule for Class and School. ★ Students should attend Google Meets for their Morning Meetings, reading and writing time, and math instruction, and for their specials. ★ Students should access their work on either Seesaw or Google Classroom. ★ Families can remind students to attend their Google Meets and to complete their asynchronous work each day. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Learning will be synchronous and asynchronous.
