

KARNS CITY AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT 2021-22 ADULT WALKING PROGRAM

1. Participants **MUST PRE-REGISTER** in the Walking Program. Participants can register in the Maintenance office by calling 724-756-2030, ext. 1016, where you will obtain a fob, or in the High School Office.
2. **A \$30.00 deposit for a key fob** (which will give you access to the Main Entrance to the High School Building) is required from each participant. This deposit shall be returned upon return of your key fob. Checks should be made out to ***“The Karns City Area School District.”***
3. To ensure proper security during the Walking Program, the doors will remain locked at all times when Walkers are in the building. Walkers are **NOT PERMITTED** to open outside doors for others. Only Pre-Registered Participants who have received a key fob may enter the building.
4. Walking will be from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday.
5. The Walking Program will start **Monday, November 15, 2021 and end on Tuesday, April 26, 2022.**
6. When school is closed due to inclement weather, the Walking Program is cancelled for that day.
7. The Walking Program will be cancelled due to the following school events:

November 25-29 - Thanksgiving vacation
December 9 - Elementary Band Christmas Concert @ HS
December 14 - Jr. High Christmas Concert
December 15 - Sr. High Christmas concert
December 23 -January 2 - Christmas break
January 17 - In-Service Day
February 18 -21 Act 80/Vacation Days
February 28 - March 5 - Musical practices/performances
March 18 - 21 - Vacation/Act 80 Days
April 14-18 - Easter vacation days

8. ***THIS PROGRAM IS FOR ADULTS AND SENIOR HIGH STUDENTS ONLY (Grades 10, 11 and 12).***
9. No babies or strollers are permitted
10. If necessary, Custodians may detour walking routes for cleaning purposes. The Maintenance Staff has **first priority**.
11. Shoes are required for walking. In the case of bad/sloppy weather, please bring clean shoes for walking.
12. This is a Walking Program only. ***Running or jogging is NOT PERMITTED.***
13. Your cooperation is needed in order to insure a pleasant, successful program. Failure to follow these rules will jeopardize the program.
