### **COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics**

This past week Scarborough Public Schools partnered with Northern Light to host school-based clinics for those families who were interested in getting their children vaccinated here at school. Northern Light confirmed that they vaccinated 666 Scarborough students ages 5-11. This is great news for our school community! We would like to thank the Northern Light organization, our school nursing teams, and all school staff who assisted with the clinics. The clinics were organized, efficient and very well run.

As the vaccine is a 2 part immunization, students who received their first dose can anticipate the second round of vaccines during the week of December 6.

Here are the specific dates and times:

Pleasant Hill Dec 6 - 9 am to 11:30 am

Middle School Dec 6 - 12 pm to 2 pm

Blue Point Dec 7 - 9 am to 11:30 am

Eight Corners Dec 7 - 12 pm to 3 pm

Wentworth Dec 8 - 9 am to 12 pm



Each building will send out logistics for parents who choose to be present for their child's second vaccination. Once fully vaccinated, students would not be subject to any kind of quarantine, either at school or in the community.

### Communication about Positive COVID Cases in Our Schools

Here is our weekly snapshot of school-related cases. Close contacts are being communicated in 2 columns, whereas the Maine CDC exempts people from school quarantine if they have classroom only contact (since we are universally masking), are fully vaccinated, or actively participating in pooled testing.

# 2021-2022 Breakfast & Lunch Ordering Protocols

As a general reminder, all breakfast and lunch meals for all students in Scarborough Schools are free for this school year 2021-2022. All existing students whose parents have an account will be able to order breakfast and lunch using the same procedure as last year, from the Nutrislice app on a device or at <a href="https://www.scarboroughschools.org/">https://www.scarboroughschools.org/</a> (at the top of the page click "Quick links", then go to School Lunch for all meal menus).

All Kindergarten and new students to the district will have to make a Nutrislice account through the Nutrislice app or through <a href="https://scarboroughschools.nutrislice.com/menu/create-account">https://scarboroughschools.nutrislice.com/menu/create-account</a> before they can order breakfast and lunch. Parents will need the child's ID# before they can start the registration process.

For breakfast meals in all of our schools, you can order online on the same day before 6:30 AM, while for lunch meals, you can order online on the same day before 7:30 AM. You can order meals for the day, or set up a weekly or monthly plan for meals to be provided to your children. The menus for all meals for a new month will be posted on the school's website and on the Nutrislice app the last Monday at the end of the previous month.

Each school has created their own system for their lunch disbursement. They are continually reviewing

towards improving and refining their daily lunch routines.
