

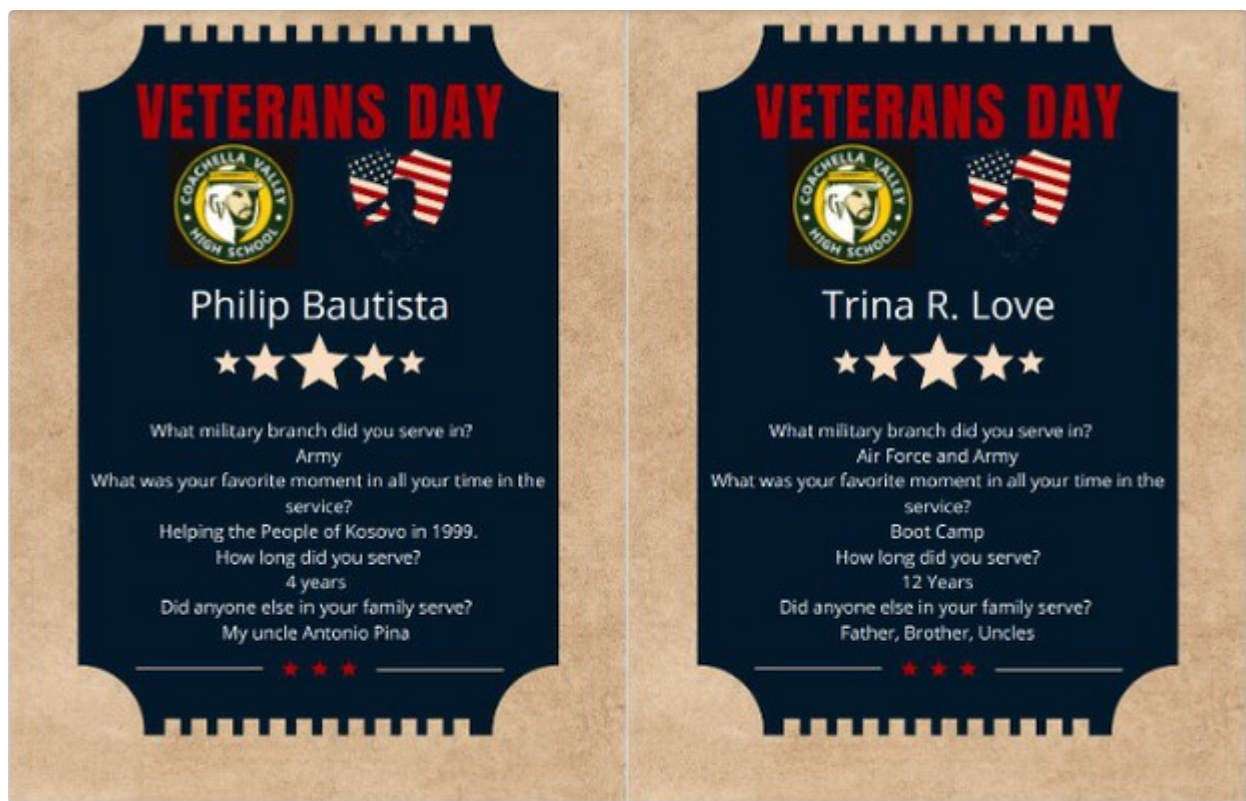

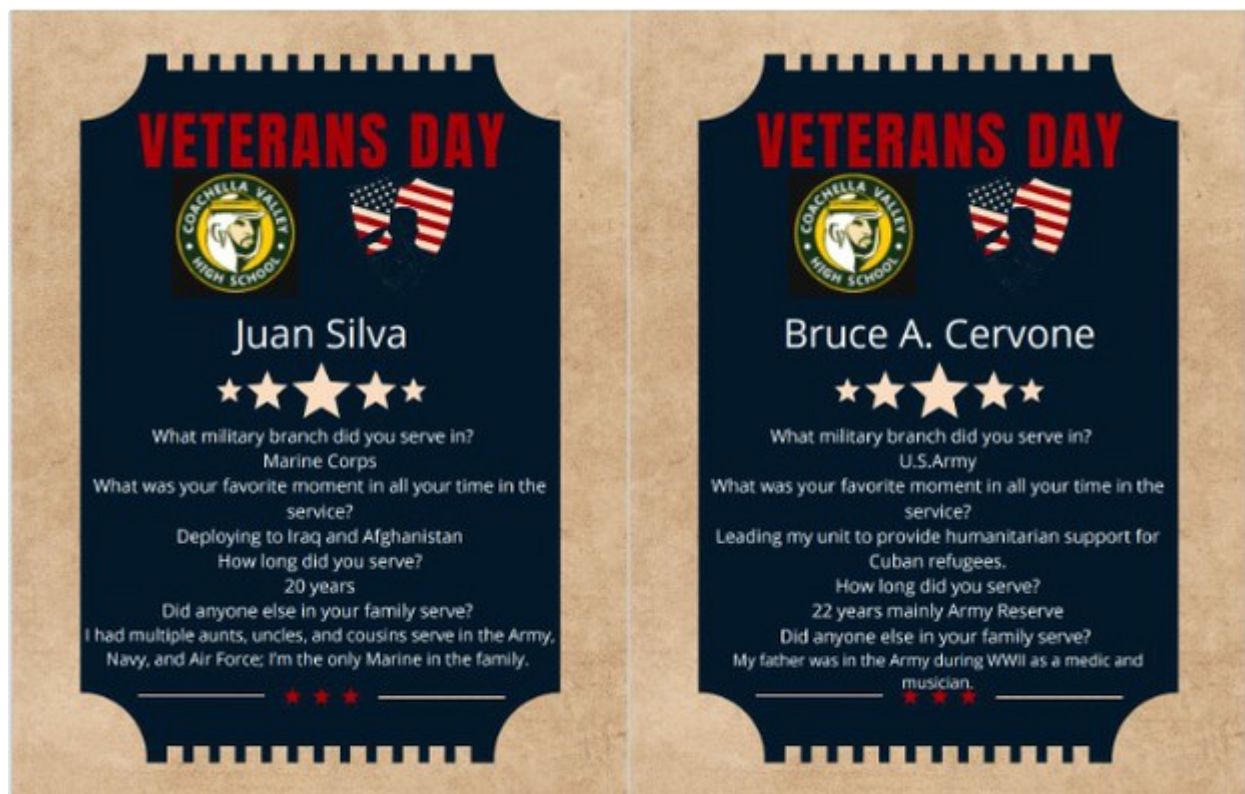

Our Girls Cross Country team will competed in CIF this weekend at MT San Jacinto, Good Luck Girls.

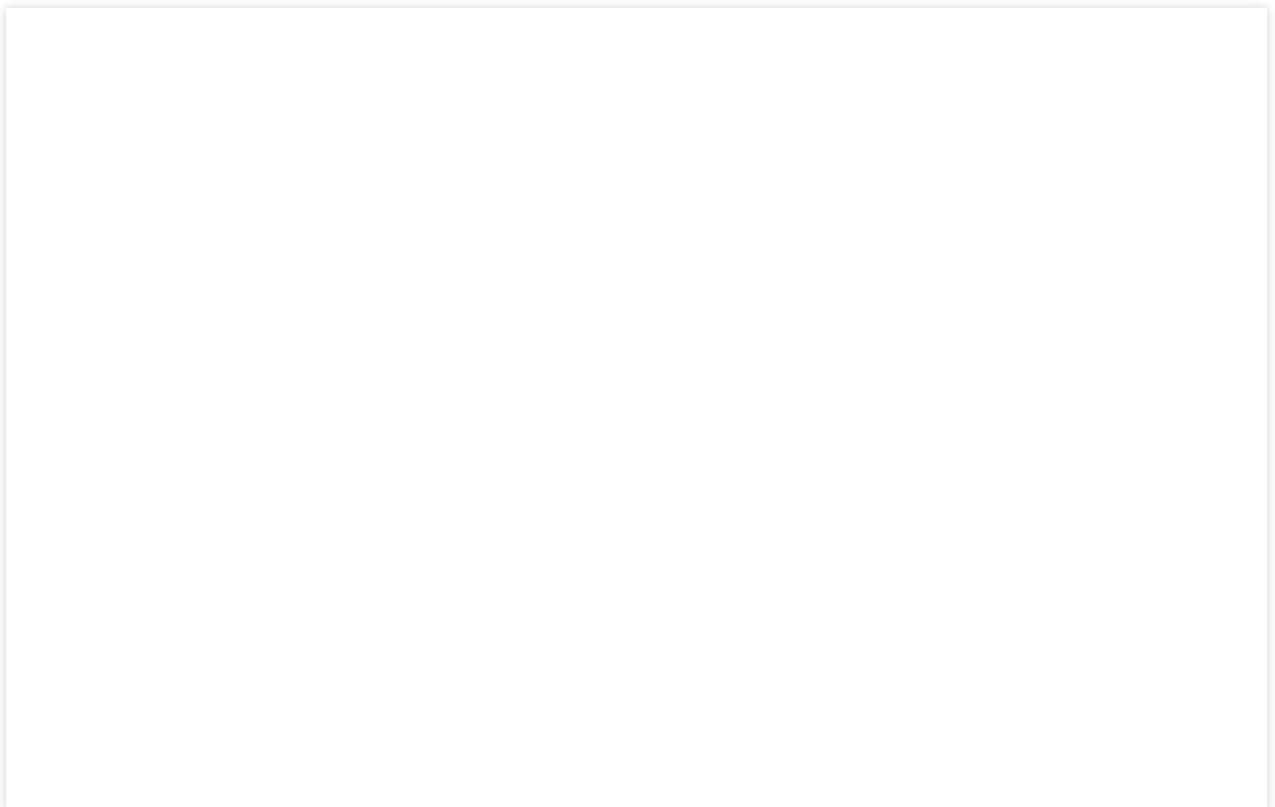
Football

HIGHLIGHT - LUNCH TIME ACTIVITIES

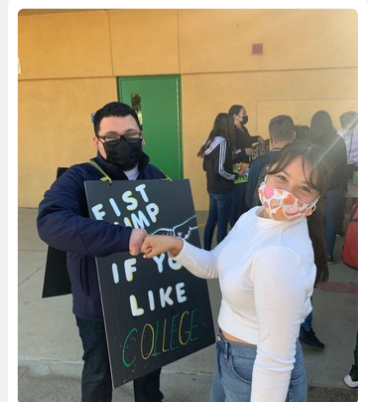
Active Minds Club
