The Mary Fusz Doody CH '66 Scholarship is available to a student entering the ninth grade (either from Villa Duchesne eighth grade or a student new to Villa Duchesne) who demonstrates a strong desire to learn and a commitment to her education.

One scholarship will be awarded each year and is renewable each academic year for a maximum of four years provided that the student maintains her eligibility, including a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or greater, and that she respects herself, her peers, and our school through her conduct. Eligible recipients must be strong academically, as demonstrated by a GPA of 3.5 or greater in grades 7-8, as well as standardized test scores in the 85 percentile or above.

Student requirements include:

- Strong academics and a financial need;
- Desire for learning and furthering personal growth, and show an active participation in her faith;
- Positive teacher recommendations;
- Evidence of strong religious beliefs; participation in the Catholic faith is preferred, but not required; and
- Submission of a reflective essay on the five *Goals and Criteria* of a Sacred Heart education and what a diverse community means to the student and their family. Please also share how you will make a difference within our Villa Duchesne School community.

To apply for the Mary Fusz Doody CH '66 Scholarship, the following are required:

- A completed Mary Fusz Doody CH '66 Scholarship application (see next sheet);
- A Villa Duchesne and Oak Hill School application form (Admissions brochure or online);
- The Archdiocesan Catholic High School Application form indicating Villa Duchesne and Oak Hill School as first choice for secondary education;
- Completed Student and School Services (SSS) application to determine financial need
- A transcript and recommendation from the principal of the elementary school or middle school; and
- A student visit day including interview and a parents' meeting, scheduled through Admissions Office.
