To meet the changing needs of students, parents, and the school, the PFE Plan is reviewed and revised each semester by the Campus Based Leadership Team (CBLT) and/or at a Parent Advisory Meeting.

Meeting Sessions

Stafford Elementary School administrators will host two fall meetings. Our first fall meeting will take place before Open House in August/September. Our second Fall meeting will take place in December. The spring meeting will take place in March. SES utilizes campus social media accounts to remind parents of all events.

Flexible Meetings

SES will host various meetings throughout the school year, some may occur before school, during the school day, and after school/evenings. Meetings can be held face-to-face or virtually. The school does offer child care for some programs and meeting dates. SES can participate in home visits when requested and deemed appropriate by the school and school district. We strongly suggest parents participate in parent-teacher conferences, ARD, and 504 meetings when applicable.

Parent Participation

The campus includes parent participation in the Campus Based Leadership Team (CBLT) who will review and revise the Campus Improvement Plan and design and implement school and educational programming.

Program Activities

Program activities include multiple opportunities for participation such as informational meetings, surveys, CBLT, and Parent University. Curriculum and assessment information are provided through campus level communication from teachers and the school, and on the CIA page of the district website. Parents are strongly encouraged to provide ideas for opportunities.

Academic Achievement

Parents are encouraged to use the parent portal for timely updates on student achievement. In addition, progress reports (every 3 weeks) and report cards (6 weeks) are provided to monitor students achievement. Also, the campus encourages parent/teacher communication regarding student achievement when a student fails to meet the passing standards for a course.

Literacy Support

Stafford Elementary School offers Amplify and related materials to help parents improve their child's achievement. Literacy support for parents is conducted through trainings (such as Parent University) and through resources provided by the campus.

Professional Development

In an effort to establish and maintain a strong partnership between the parents and school, Stafford Elementary School will utilize campus professional development and CBLT meetings to educate school personnel on effective working relationships with parents.

Technology Education

Parent technology education will be addressed through district-wide programs to foster parental involvement. Stafford MSD offers one to one technology in all classrooms.
