Additionally, we request access to all BCSD decisions, policies and rules governing the bilateral and unilateral placement of students in non-public schools and non-public agencies, including but not limited to the decisions, policies and rules governing the placement of students where it is alleged and/or determined and/or agreed that BCSD failed to provide a free and appropriate public education. We also request access to all settlement agreements, attorney bills and invoices, and contracts with non-public schools and non-public agencies in the placement of students in such non-public schools and non-public agencies where unilaterally or bilaterally BCSD determined that it could not provide an appropriate public educational program.

We request this information to include the period from Fall 2009 through Spring 2018. In order to help to determine my status to access fees, you should know that I am an individual seeking information for personal use.
