Teacher Report Card Survey: The Teacher Report Card Survey window is halfway complete, and I want to provide a status update for you. I am including another reminder in the Monday Memo from Dr. Rhoads as a follow up to this reminder.

Attached are all counts of completed surveys as of today, currently 11 schools have zero surveys **TEACHER OPINION SURVEY:** The online teacher survey portal opened on **Wednesday, March 21**, and the survey can be accessed from the State Department of Education website: <https://ed.sc.gov/surveys/teacher-survey/>.

Teachers will need the 7 digit SIDN number for the school to complete the survey. The 2018SchoolList file is included with all BCSD SIDN numbers.

This year, the teacher survey still has the same format and same questions. The survey takes approximately 10 minutes to complete. If the school name appearing on the survey form is not the right school, exit the survey and reenter the school identification number. Please understand there is a timeline for completing the teacher survey online. **The portal opened on March 21 and closes on April 23.**

Who completes this survey? *Teachers, librarians, guidance counselors, and speech therapists* at their school should complete the teacher survey. *Part-time teachers* may complete a survey form if they are *on campus at least half of each school day or week*. The survey may be completed using any computer with internet access. Teachers may use their home computers. completed, the deadline for the survey is April 23.

Your staff will need your school number to access the survey, it is included in this email to the left of your school name.

As you may have noticed on the Beaufort High School online calendar [here](#), 4/4 is designated as the next Collaborative Coalition Session.

April 4th will be utilized to train all teaching staff on the administration of the WIN assessment which is the new name of the WorkKey's exam. This will be our final state-mandated "high stakes" exam. Please keep in mind that we still have AP testing (5/7 – 5/18), EOC exams (5/21 – 5/30), Senior Exams (5/14 - 5/18), Final Exams (5/21 - 5/30), and AAPPL testing (4/30 - 5/18). We have had a tremendous amount of testing this year. Unfortunately, with the secure testing environment regulations International Studies hall because of its ability to have ample space and ease of securability **has already been used two times this year** for the PRE-ACT & ACT. Additionally, many teachers with all juniors or classrooms in IS have been asked to carry the majority of the test administration burden.

For the WIN test we are asking for volunteer teachers to administer this exam to ease the burden carried by our colleagues. Your classes will be covered for the duration of the exam.
