To earn academic equivalency credits at Puget Sound Skills Center (PSSC), a student must be enrolled in a Career & Technical Education (CTE) program for a minimum of two semesters AND earn full credit and a "C" or above. Students may only apply *once* for each of the equivalency credits available.
