That looks right to me. The levels Alisa is referring to are the English Language Development levels that are concurrent with the results of the ACCESS test - the annual English Language Development test required by all English Learners who are not exited from the program. Students must score a composite score of 4.4 AND at least a 4.0 in each language domain (reading, writing, listening, and speaking). The ACCESS test measures English Language Development in both social language and the academic language in the grade level content areas. See pages 8 and 9 of the document from our BCSD ESOL Webpage.

2014-15 sheet: looks like it is total number of ESOL students levels 1-5 at each school in PK(-1) through 12th grade, and maybe GT stands for Gifted and Talented.

2015-16 sheet: looks like levels coded in Power School 1-6, 6NE means proficient but didn't meet criteria for exiting "not exited", 6P means exited "proficient", 7P means second year exited.

2016-17 sheet; looks like same codes, not sure what Power School coding was for the letters

2017-2018: P3 is third year exited, we now have to monitor for 4 years after exiting, W is waiver and parents waive services but students have to test ACCESS test.

Coding and exiting requirements have changed over the last few years so it gets confusing.
