The Bistro


This area is called our, “Bistro.” The Bistro provides a cafe like area where students can work individually or in small groups.

At The Academy, we know that physical engagement is critical when stimulating learners intellectually. To emphasize this point, you will often see students using one of our three gyms.




Summit

Welcome to the Summit! Students use this space to receive academic support, use a computer or printer, or even if they just need a place to meet with their teachers.




Art Rooms
