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# ELPAC Testing

ELPAC regulations require districts to administer the Initial ELPAC to all eligible students in kindergarten through twelve (K–12)... whose primary language is a language other than English.

Districts also are required to administer the Summative ELPAC annually to students identified as ELs until they are RFEP (Reclassified Fluent English Proficient).

# Exámenes ELPAC

Los reglamentos de ELPAC requiere que administren los exámenes iniciales de ELPAC a todos los alumnos elegibles de kínder a doceavo grado (K-12), ...quienes su idioma principal es otro idioma que no sea inglés.

También se requiere que los Distritos administren los exámenes Sumativos ELPAC anualmente a los estudiantes identificados como ELs (aprendices de inglés) anualmente hasta que sean reclasificados con dominio de inglés (RFEP).

# Who is tested?

The ELPAC assesses public school students in K–12 in the following four domains in English:

- Listening
- Speaking
- Reading
- Writing
