Legacy Scholarship

Description

Since its earliest days in 1910, boarding at Garrison Forest School has been a treasured tradition. Generations of alumnae have benefited from the enriching experience of learning and living at Garrison Forest.

Garrison Forest offers two merit-based legacy scholarships for any new student or current day student entering Grades 8-12 to board at Garrison Forest. These awards recognize exceptional character and academic achievement. The Legacy Scholarship covers the difference in cost between day and boarding tuition. Both current students and new applicants who are alumnae daughters, granddaughters, nieces, or sisters are eligible to apply. Scholarships are renewable each year with good academic standing.

Application Process

Applicants should complete the Legacy Scholarship Essay by **February 4, 2022**. The essay must be written by the student, and should be sent to Catie Gibbons, Director of Enrollment Management, by email at catiegibbons@gfs.org. Finalists will be invited to interview with a member of the Legacy Scholarship Committee in February.
