



A Safety Message to Parents

We are asking for your assistance. Please check to see what your children take to school in their backpacks or in their vehicles. Please remind them that items such as toy guns, toy knives, lighters, and other contraband are not allowed and any violation will be taken seriously. All incidents will be reported to the BISD Police and Security Services Department.

From the first day of the school to the last, BISD campuses are places to learn and should be safe, welcoming, and secure. Drugs, alcohol, weapons, and disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Any student who violates laws at school will not only be subject to disciplinary action as stated in BISD Board Policies, but may also be subject to arrest by the police and/or legal action may be taken.
