Community

Twin Valley High School is a comprehensive public high school with a total enrollment of approximately 1,100 students in grades 9 through 12. The faculty consists of 80 teachers, 5 school counselors, 1 librarian, and 1 school nurse. All faculty are certified; 70 hold advanced degrees.

The campus is rich with diverse opportunities for student growth and learning potential in both individual and group settings. The high school is located in a rural setting, two miles east of Morgantown, where exit 298 of the Pennsylvania Turnpike is located. It is geographically centered within the school district, which is comprised of municipalities in Berks and Chester counties.

Twin Valley offers over 190 courses across a diverse academic curriculum. Courses are offered in a 4 x 4 block schedule format, with 78 minute periods. Our acclaimed internship program serves as a capstone to our various career clusters, while providing students with real world opportunities to work side by side with professionals in the community. Additional offerings include half-day career and technical education at Berks Career and Technical Center and Technical College High School. An esteemed pre-engineering program through a 14-year partnership with Project Lead the Way is available to students in grades 9-12, as well as both on and off campus college dual enrollment opportunities.

During the 20-21 school year, as a result of the COVID pandemic, students were provided a choice of attending classes in a face to face setting, attending their TVHS classes through livestreaming, or working through our Twin Valley Virtual Academy (TVVA). Classes were available in-person to anyone wishing to attend in-person. For the 21-22 school year, only in-person and Twin Valley Virtual Academy are available options.

Graduation Requirement

Students must earn 24 credits to be eligible for graduation. The credits must be earned in the following content areas: Mathematics (4), Social Studies (4), English (4), Science (4), PE/Health/Wellness (2), Electives (6)

146 students completed 158 dual enrollment courses between 2019 and 2021.


\$114, 900 in local /community based scholarship money was awarded to 2021 graduates.

HONOR ROLL


Students that earn a GPA of at least 3.5950 and have no quarter grades less than 85% are placed on **Distinguished Honor Roll**.

Students that earn a GPA of at least a 3.2 and have no quarter grade less than 75% are placed on **Honor Roll.**


2021 MEAN SAT Scores
