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2021-22 Bridgewater Raritan Regional School District Goals

1. Entering the 2021/22 school year, 44% of Bridgewater-Raritan Regional students (3614 in total) have not attended school in person for eighteen months. **“The Road Forward”** guidance released by the New Jersey Department of Education in June 2021 states: **“Local Education Agencies (LEA) must plan to provide full-day, full time, in-person instruction and operations for the 2021-22 school year.”**

The primary goal for the 2021-22 school year is to reacclimate students and parents into the in-person learning environment. This goal will maintain focus on the following areas.

- **Health and safety of students and staff**
 - Establish practices that support a layered approach to help prevent the spread of Covid-19. These practices will include:
 - General Health and Safety Guidelines
 - Cleaning, Disinfection, and Airflow
 - Screening, Exclusion, and Response to Symptomatic Students and Staff
 - Contact Tracing
 - Testing
 - **Provide conditions of learning that will foster the social and emotional well-being of students, families, and staff.**
 - **Ensure equitable access and utilization of grade-level materials and high-level resources.**
 - **Implement a K-12 Accelerated Learning Cycle to mitigate learning gaps that occurred during the pandemic.**
 - Develop a plan utilizing the district’s additional federal and state funding allocations to support the return to full-time, in-person instruction and operations for the 2021-22 school year.
2. Analyze our entire physical plant to develop a facilities plan prioritizing health, wellness, safety, and positive academic outcomes within the Bridgewater-Raritan Regional School District community.
