Overview

Instrumental Music

The Instrumental Music program at MOT Charter High School offers pathways for wind and brass instruments, orchestral strings, concert percussion, and piano. Students are placed in Wind Ensemble, String Orchestra, Drumline, or Music Theory/Piano according to their major instrument, and have the opportunity to enroll in additional courses and ensembles as electives or extracurriculars. All students focus on developing music literacy, instrumental technique, and musicianship, and perform in frequent concerts throughout the year.

Vocal Music

The Vocal Music program at MOT Charter High School focuses on developing healthy vocal technique, music literacy, sight singing, aural skills, musicality, and an understanding of vocal anatomy. Students are members of the MOT Concert Choir, performing diverse repertoire in frequent concerts and public events throughout the year. Students may also enroll in our Music Theory/Piano elective courses and participate in additional ensembles as extracurricular activities.
