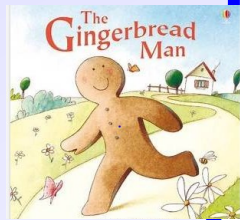




## Dear Parents and Carers 22.11.21

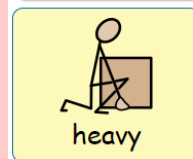
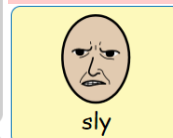
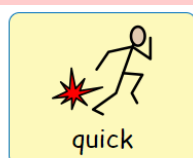
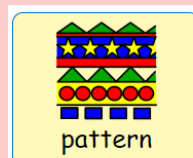
