Position: Adult Basketball Official - Part Time Seasonal

Summary: The Adult Basketball Official works under the direct supervision of the Recreation Program Manager and alongside the gym supervisor. This position performs those duties directly relating to control and officiating of organized competitive adult basketball sport.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- WIAA or other sport association certification preferred.
- Officials will have thorough knowledge of NFHS basketball rules and regulations and ability to apply them according to game play.
- Officials will approach the position as a representative of the department, displaying respect for the facility, participants, and co-workers.

Responsibilities:

- Work collaboratively with all other district and department personnel.
- Representative of the Recreation Department, uphold and exemplify department policies and guidelines in all aspects of job performance and in relationships with children, families and district employees as outlined in the department employee handbook.
- Ability to facilitate conflict resolution and independently solve as directed by immediate supervisor or department administrator.
- Arrive dressed properly to perform duties.
- Communicate expectations of behavior during games and check the court for any safety hazards and address them, if applicable.
- Officials will remain unbiased while officiating and will avoid verbal contact with spectators.
- Officials will work in a timely manner including starting, stopping and maintaining the scheduled game times.
- Ensure all players are in proper uniform and teams are ready for play.
- Other duties as assigned by immediate supervisor or department administrator.
