



Triangle Community Foundation is pleased to announce the creation of the NC Diversity and Equity in Emergency Medicine Scholarship Fund, which was created out of a desire to increase the number of underrepresented minorities in the medical field, specifically in emergency medicine. Scholarship applications are now being accepted and will be awarded to second year MD or DO students or first-year Physician Assistant students who identify as underrepresented minorities and are attending school in North Carolina or at Meharry Medical College in TN.

Awards will be \$5,000 per year for the number of years remaining in the student's program (one or two years) and may be used towards any need listed under the school's total cost of attendance. The student is responsible for all other charges. To receive a second year of funding, students must verify they continue to be in good academic standing and that they will be enrolled for the upcoming academic year.
