Hello Samantha Smith Families,

Do not forget that Wednesday the 24th is a half day ending at 11:50am. This is not a normal Wednesday early release. We hope your family is able to enjoy the long weekend. If you celebrate Thanksgiving, Happy Thanksgiving.

Each day we are learning of more and more students who have received their first dose of the Covid Vaccine. If you were not able to find a vaccination appointment, you can visit for more information. The Washington State Department of Health website has added children's vaccines to their vaccine locator webpage: <u>Vaccinate WA: Find COVID-19 Vaccine Appointments Near You</u>. Doses are limited across the country at this time.

Our staff members are not required to check their emails during the evening or on the weekend. If you need to communicate a positive Covid case, please email me (Mrs. Warner) directly at <u>jwarner@lwsd.org</u>. Please note that all positive cases are reported to the school by the Department of Health. We ask for your partnership in letting us know as soon as you know, to help keep others safe.

Are you ready for inclement weather?

When emergency conditions such as snow and ice or windstorms result in school schedule changes, the district will notify families directly through our SchoolMessenger automated phone system. Families with students who ride the bus should watch their mail in mid-November for a postcard with information about their bad weather bus route.

Students go out to recess rain or shine. Please send your student daily ready for the weather. Raincoats, rain boots and umbrellas are allowed.

Please help our school stay safe. If your child is sick, keep them home. If your child has any of these symptoms, they must stay home. If they are not kept home, they will be sent home. Covid Symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4 or above (a student does not have to have a fever to have Covid)
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Fatigue
- Muscle pain or body aches
- Headache
- Loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat

- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
