Math 7 earned-advanced option: Students have the opportunity to extend their work beyond course expectations to earn advanced credit. All students are candidates for advanced credit. Students pursuing advanced credit must first show mastery of class-taught concepts and express a desire to apply their understanding in original ways.

Middle School Athletics: In Grades 7 and 8, students choose between participation on a team sport at School, a non-competitive fitness activity at school, or a non-school-sponsored physical activity. Two seasons of athletic engagement are required.

Quests 7 & 8

Languages: Students have the option to take French or Spanish and make a commitment to sustain language study in the chosen language for the four years of Middle School. Spanish and French 7 & 8 is equivalent to the Upper School French or Spanish I course. Newly enrolled Grade 8 students may select an Introduction to Spanish course, or, with the successful completion of a placement test, be placed into Spanish 8 or French 8.
