

Statement of Compliance

Evidence of Compliance

Beaufort County School District has established the superintendent's expectations regarding the use of volunteers in the district's programs. Administrative rule **IS-42 School Volunteers** supports volunteer programs which are professionally organized and promote better educational opportunities for students. The administration believes in using resources in the community to increase the learning opportunities for students. The administration also believes

that the appropriate use of volunteers will allow teachers to function in their professional capacities.

Beaufort County School District has established the superintendent's expectations regarding the importance of parent conferences. Administrative rule **IS-45 Parent Conferences** addresses the expectation of close communication between home and school. Personal conferences between parents/legal guardians and teachers supplement the formal reporting system of eight times a year. The administration expects teachers to schedule conferences with parents/legal guardians at least once per year, and more frequently, if necessary.

Progress Reports and Report Cards: Progress reports are sent home to parents/guardians of all students at the midpoint of each quarter. Report cards are sent home at the end of each quarter. The purpose of these reports is to communicate student progress in all classes. Distribution dates are indicated on the district calendar. Teachers are expected to contact parents when a student's grade drops below a C/70.

Administrative rule **E-7 Public Information and Communication.** It will be the policy of the district to keep the community informed of the objectives, achievements, needs and conditions of the school system. The administration will seek to keep the citizens of the district regularly and thoroughly informed through all channels of communications.

Initiatives supporting family engagement include:

- Parent connections and/or participation via the updated district website.
- Use of social media as a communication tool for parents and students. Facebook and Twitter is used to share district and individual school websites and information.
- The “BCSD Between the Lines” electronic newsletter provides current information about school events, reports and publications.
- The Office of Communications provides current news releases to the news media, the district’s website and social media.
- School newsletters- all of the district’s schools produce weekly newsletters for students, parents, and community members.
- Schools utilize an automated telephone message system to provide pertinent information to families.
- Video productions highlighting initiatives in the district are produced by the Beaufort County Television Channel along with video podcasts featuring messages from the Superintendent.
- The BCSD offers and iPhone/ Android App for access to information.
- The district offers “School Choice” events to inform and support students and families

in the decision making process for enrollment in choice programs.

- All schools in the district have a state-mandated School Improvement Council to support shared decision making with school stakeholders.
- Individual schools offer recognition events supporting students and their families.
- The district offers “Financial Aid Night” events to support and inform students and parents about the college application and enrollment process.
